Intervale Road Repaving - Bid Results - Bids for this project were received on June 16th. A total of eight bids were received, ranging from a low of \$396,370.70 to a high of \$431,273.43. The low bid, offered by Your Way Construction Corp, is \$24,000 higher than the project estimate produced in January of this year.

Although the bid price is \$24,000 higher than originally estimated, taking into consideration current market conditions and the potential for prices to further escalate, the Borough Engineer and I both agree that this bid should be awarded to the low

Depending on actual costs for other roadwork in the annual capital budget, there may be a need to fund all or a portion of the \$24,000 shortfall. Should this occur, our CFO and I both recommend funding via the Capital Improvement Fund account balance (fully

Police Car Lease - During the Borough Council meeting of May 23, 2022, Council authorized approval of a lease agreement for two police patrol vehicles. Prior to executing the lease, we discovered that the lease needed to follow the public bidding process. The bid process resulted in one bid submission. A resolution authorizing acceptance of the bid is being placed on the agenda for the June 27, 2022 Borough

RESOLUTIONS

R127-22, AUTHORIZING THE CANCELLATION OF GENERAL CAPITAL RECEIVABLE AND APPROPRIATION BALANCE - this resolution authorizes the cancellation of the \$17,901.93 balance of the NJDOT grant for Ordinance #10-21. The North Glen Road project reimbursable costs were less than the budgeted amount.

R128-22, AUTHORIZING THE REFUND OF OVERPAYMENT OF TAXES - this resolution, requested by the Borough Tax Collector, authorizes a refund in the amount of \$13,839.19 for an overpayment of taxes for Block 82 Lot 1. The mortgage company made a payment on a 100% tax exempt property.

R129-22 AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR INTERVALE ROAD

IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - this resolution authorizes the Borough Manager to enter into a contract with Your Way Construction Corp. in the amount of \$396,370.70 for the Intervale Road Improvement Project. The Borough Engineer and Borough Attorney reviewed bids that were submitted and have recommended the award.



Code of Ethics for Vendors

(viewable online at http://www.state.nj.us/transportation/business/procurement/ethics.shtm & http://njdotintranet.dot.state.nj.us/policy/ethics/pdf/vendcode.pdf)

The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) considers the maintenance of public trust and confidence essential to its proper functioning. Vendors must be notified of their responsibilities concerning their relationship with Special State Officers or employees and State officers or employees. Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988). Accordingly, NJDOT has adopted this Code of Ethics for Vendors.

"Vendor" means any general contractor, subcontractor, consultant, supplier, lessor, person, firm, corporation, association or organization providing goods and/or services or seeking to do business with the NIDOT. Vendors who supply goods or services, or are seeking to provide goods and services, to NIDOT, must adhere to the standards set forth in this Code of Ethics to avoid conflicts of interest.

This Code of Ethics, originally adopted on December 16, 1987, is based upon the principles established in Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988), the Conflict of Interest Law, and the Uniform Ethics Code and has been established pursuant to the authority of N.J.S.A. 27:1A, et seq. The Conflict of Interest Law, N.J.S.A. 52:13D-12 et seq., and Uniform Ethics Code which, while not strictly applicable to contractors, prohibit certain actions by State officers or employees and Special State officers or employees when interacting with vendors.

This Code of Ethics is included in each Request for Proposal (RFP) promulgated by the NJDOT and incorporated by reference in every contract and agreement to which the NJDOT is a party. It shall be distributed to all parties who presently do business with NJDOT and posted on the NJDOT's website.

- No vendor shall employ any NIDOT officer or employee who performs purchasing functions for NIDOT. N.J.A.C. 16:44-11.1(b)(3); Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988).
- No vendor shall sell or provide any interest in the business of the vendor to any NJDOT officer
 or employee who performs purchasing functions for NJDOT. N.J.A.C. 16:44-11.1(b)(3); Executive
 Order 189 (Kean 1988).

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- No vendor shall cause or influence, or attempt to cause or influence, any NJDOT officer or employee in his or her official capacity in any manner which might tend to impair the objectivity or independence of judgment of that NJDOT officer or employee. N.J.A.C. 16:44-11.1(b)(5); Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988).
- No vendor shall cause or influence, or attempt to cause or influence, any NJDOT officer or employee to use or attempt to use his or her official position to secure any unwarranted privileges or advantages for that vendor or for any other person. N.J.A.C. 16:44-11.1(b)(6); Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988).
- 5. No vendor shall offer any NJDOT officer or employee, his/her spouse, immediate family member, partner or associate any gift, favor, service or other thing of value related in any way to the State official's public duties. N.J.S.A. 52:13D-24; N.J.A.C. 16:44-11.1(b)(1); Uniform Ethics Code, Section III, page 6; Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988). This includes, but is not limited to, meals, discounts on goods and services, tickets to events, and clothing.

There exist certain narrow exceptions to the State of New Jersey's zero tolerance policy on the acceptance of gifts. A NJDOT officer or employee may accept the following items of minimal or nominal value.

- a. Snacks of minimal monetary value, such as coffee or donuts, provided during the course of a meeting, conference or other occasion where the officer or employee is properly in attendance.
- b. Unsolicited small items of nominal value such as pens, pencils, or other trivial logo items that are offered to the general public.
- A trophy, plaque or certificate.
- Vendors who violate this code may be subject to debarment procedures set forth at N.J.A.C. 16:44-11.1 et seq.

This Code of Ethics shall supplement, not replace, Executive Order 189 (Kean 1988), N.J.S.A. 52:13D-12, et seq., N.J.A.C. 19:61-1.1, et seq.; and Uniform Ethics Code (February 2011).

Please also see the New Jersey Department of the Treasury's "Business Ethics Guide" (http://www.state.nj.us/treasury/purchase/ethics_guide.shtml) which provides a guide to ethical conduct for persons and/or entities doing business with the State. To the extent that there is any conflict between the NJDOT Code of Ethics for Vendors and Treasury's Business Ethics Guide, the latter shall govern.



WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:31-23 authorizes one municipality to provide water and sewer service to properties in another municipality with the consent of both municipalities; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:31-12 provides for a lien on real property serviced by municipal water systems for fees and charges without regard to the location of the real property being serviced; and

WHEREAS, water and sewer services for users in certain locations in the Borough of Mountain Lakes have been historically provided through the Town of Boonton water system;

WHEREAS, the Town and the Borough wish to confirm the approval of the Borough of Mountain Lakes for the Town of Boonton to provide water and sewer service to the properties in the Borough of Mountain Lakes designated in this agreement and to establish a procedure for the enforcement of municipal utility liens on properties serviced.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Town of Boonton and the Borough of Mountain Lakes, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein set forth, agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Properties Serviced by The Town of Boonton</u>. The Borough of Mountain Lakes consents to the Town of Boonton providing water and sewer service to certain properties located in the Borough of Mountain Lakes (see attached list).
- Lien Enforcement. The Town of Boonton shall provide water and sewer service in the same manner with the same rates and charges as provided under Town of Boonton ordinances for service. Fees and charges shall constitute liens on real property served pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:31-12. The Borough of Mountain Lakes agrees to cooperate with the Town of Boonton in the enforcement of the statutory lien by noting on its real property records that utility services are provided by the Town of Boonton and that the property is subject to a municipal utility lien for services provided by the Town of Boonton. The Tax Collectors from each municipality shall create a mechanism and process for the Town of Boonton utility liens to be enforced by tax sale in the Borough of Mountain Lakes pursuant to statute. Under no circumstances shall the Borough of Mountain Lakes be responsible for unpaid utility balances for services authorized by this Agreement.
- 3. <u>Severability</u>. In the event any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, such finding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remaining portions of this Agreement. The failure of either party to insist upon strict performance of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement or to exercise any of its rights under the Agreement shall not waive such rights and such party shall have the right to enforce such rights at any time and take such action as may be lawful and authorized under this Agreement, in law or in equity.
- 4. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement and the performance thereof shall be governed, interpreted, construed and regulated by the laws of the State of New Jersey.
- 5. <u>Termination of Agreement</u>. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving at least ninety (90) days written notice to the other party.

Each proposal, when submitted, must be enclosed in a sealed envelope endorsed with the name and address of the Bidder, and endorsed with the name of the Owner and Contract Number 2022.06, and Title. Said sealed envelope shall be delivered to the Owner at the time and place, and marked to the attention of the person, all as designated in the Notice to Bidders.

Proposals must be typed or written in ink on the blank forms provided. Prices must be given both in writing and in numerical values. In the case of a difference, the written price shall govern. In the event of a mathematical error in any price extension(s), and/ or in the total bid figure, the Owner will recalculate same using the written price(s); and the resulting recalculated bid price will be used in determining the actual bid amount.

Proposals which are incomplete, conditional or obscure, or which contain additions not called for, erasures, alterations or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected as informal. If any information required herein is not provided, the proposal shall be deemed irregular and for which cause may be rejected as informal and not considered.

No proposal, after it shall have been opened, shall be withdrawn except as may be permitted hereinafter at Paragraph 16.0.

4.0 AWARD OF THE CONTRACT

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest formal and responsible bidder who, in the judgment of the officials of the Owner, is best qualified to do this work; and the Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities. Proposals which do not show adequate proof of the qualifications of the bidder or do not otherwise conform to the requirements of this Contract, will be rejected.

The award of the Contract will be made by the Owner as soon as practicable after the acceptance of the bids, and the Contract will be awarded or all bids will be rejected within sixty (60) days after the opening of the bids, except that the bids of any bidders who consent thereto, may, at the request of the Owner, be held for consideration for such longer period as may be agreed.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of opening bids, but may do so at any time prior to the time for the opening thereof; except for Bidders claiming a mistake under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.3 as further described at Paragraph 16.0 herein.

6.0 EXECUTION OF CONTRACT AND BOND

The bidder to whom the Contract is awarded will be required to execute the Contract within twenty (20) calendar days from the date when the Notice of Award is delivered to the bidder. The Notice of Award shall be accompanied by the necessary Contract forms. In case of failure of the bidder to execute the Contract within the time above stated, the Owner may at his option consider the bidder in default.

10.0 BUY AMERICAN

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-18, only manufactured products of the United States, wherever available, shall be used for the work to be performed under this Contract.

11.0 EQUAL BIDS

When two or more bids are equal in all respects, award may be made at the discretion of the Owner by a lottery drawing which shall be witnessed by at least three (3) persons and which may be attended by the bidders or their representatives.

12.0 SALES TAX

The Owner is a body politic and corporate and as such is qualified under the New Jersey Sales Tax Law for exemption from the sales tax.

13.0 SUBCONTRACTORS

When applicable in accordance with P.L. 1997, c. 408, the Bidder shall include with his Proposal a list of names of the subcontractors to be utilized for the Project. Additionally, in accordance with P.L. 1997, c. 408, Bidders who will use more than one subcontractor for any of the specialty trades enumerated in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-16, must submit a certificate, simultaneously with his bid, listing each subcontractor named for the particular specialty trade. The certificate shall set forth the scope of work for which the subcontractor has submitted a price quote and which the Bidder has agreed to award to the subcontractor should the Bidder be awarded the Contract. If the Bidder fails to submit the required certificate, the Owner shall award the Contract to the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

14.0 NEW JERSEY BUSINESS REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with P.L. 2004, c. 57, the Bidder shall include with his Proposal a copy of the Business Registration Certificate issued by the Department of the Treasury, Division of Revenue. In addition, the Contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors and suppliers of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the Contractor. The requirement of proof of business registration extends down through all levels (tiers) of the project.

Before final payment on the Contract is made by the Contracting agency, the Contractor shall submit an accurate list and the proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the Contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used.

Therefore, the Owner will utilize the exception to the 30-day payment period and billing may be approved and certified at the next scheduled public meeting of the entity's governing body, and paid during the entity's subsequent payment cycle.

16.0. WITHDRAWAL OF BID - N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.3



PERIOD OF CONTRACT

After receipt by the Contractor of the acceptance of his proposal, the Contractor shall complete the performance of the entire work within the time specified as follows:

120 DAYS

INSURANCE/BACKGROUND CHECKS

The contractor is responsible to conduct adequate background checks on all employees and/or subcontractors working at Borough facilities. Contractors and/or subcontractors must be bonded, show proof of insurance coverage naming the Borough as an additional insured, and workers' compensation insurance.

CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT

PENALTIES



MAY 2022

ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

A few of the residential addition projects which received zoning permit approval have gone through the code review process and will be starting construction in June. Property owners seem to realize that the inflated prices and difficulties with the supply chain may be the new normal and are reluctantly pushing forward with their renovation projects. As expected, homeowners are doing mechanical replacements in preparation for the summer and fall.

The construction permits have been issued for the demolition of the Zeris Inn building and adjacent residential dwelling. A large portion of the commercial building has been removed with the remaining work to be completed by the end of June. A preconstruction meeting was held to discuss issues and concerns which may be encountered during site work and construction of the Wawa facility.

New regulations pertaining to the electronic submission of permit applications and online plan reviews may not materialize until the end of 2023. Plans will be made during the preparation of the 2023 proposed municipal budget for hardware and software upgrades to accommodate these regulations. As details become available the extent of the changes to the budget will be better understood.

May Health Department Activity Report - 2022

Our May 2022 report identifies the activities of the Health Officer, Health Department and staff and provides an overview of the various tasks completed by the department. Additional supplemental reports from Environmental, Nursing, and Health Education are forwarded to clarify activities.

Vaccine clinic needs are not desired by the public at this time, but we provide COVID vaccines to any individual or family that makes a request.

NEW FROM MAY Guidance/Executive Orders:

- 5/5/22 the <u>Food and Drug Administration (FDA)</u> limited the authorized use of the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 Vaccine to:
 - o Individuals 18 years of age and older for whom other authorized or approved COVID-19 vaccines are not accessible or clinically appropriate, and to
 - Individuals 18 years of age and older who elect to receive the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 Vaccine because they would otherwise not receive a COVID-19 vaccine.
 - o Individuals should discuss the benefits and risks of COVID-19 vaccination brands with their healthcare provider to determine which vaccine is right for them.
- 5/16: NJDOH updated information on where to find COVID-19 testing.
- 5/17: NJDOH has updated information on COVID-19 therapeutic treatments and where to access them.
- 5/19: Everyone ages 5 and older who has completed their primary series is now eligible for a booster dose to further enhance their protection against the COVID-19 virus and its variants.

Recent Notable Updates:

There has been a marked increase in COVID case counts throughout the state in the past two
weeks. Additionally, a great number of schools and care facilities in our jurisdictions are
experiencing COVID outbreaks. More information on these outbreaks can be found on the
NJDOH COVID Data Dashboard under the "Schools" and "Long Term Care" tabs.

We participated in ongoing Zoom and Teams meetings with NJ Department of Health, County Agencies, LINCS and Health Officers, still occurring as needed.

The Nursing Department continued to investigate the spike in cases especially any identified outbreaks in schools, nursing homes and senior citizen facilities and provides information on the guidance changes.

During this past month we have experienced a measurable increase in the level of COVID-19 activity, however, at the very end of the month the numbers began to level off.

As of May 27, 2022 Mt. Lakes has 18 cases with a 14-day look back as compared to April 27, 2022 15 cases and compared to March 30, 2022 4 cases. Thus, we can see the case levels have increased over the past two months. Hospitalizations and ICU COVID cases have been relatively stable over the past several weeks with a slight increase.

Activities

- Participate in meetings and ongoing guidance from NJDOH/CDC regarding best practices for quarantine and vaccine programs.
- Provided weekly COVID report by Friday with State updates, CALI Score and Charts.
- Continue to inform, discuss and answer questions from residents, business owners and agencies regarding issues that are important to them.
- Continue to monitor staff activities regarding public health inspections and complaints. (see environmental, health education and nursing reports)

Testing and Vaccination Sites:

Both public and private sites continue to operate limitedly throughout New Jersey.

Presently a majority of tests are being completed by individuals using rapid antigen tests instead of laboratory PCR tests.
