ORDINANCE NO. 12-2024

CALENDAR YEAR 2024

**AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION
LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK
(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Dover in the County of Morris finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that a 1% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$237,028.86 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council hereby determine that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Dover, in the County of Morris, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Town of Dover shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$829,601.02, and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Town of Dover be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DOVER AWARDING A CONTRACT TO CORONIS HEALTH RCM THROUGH THE PASSAIC COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Town of Dover previously authorized *via* Resolution No. 93-2024 the execution of an Agreement with the County of Passaic to become a member of the Passaic County Cooperative Pricing System #38PCCP (the “Cooperative Pricing System”); and

WHEREAS, the Town subsequently executed an Agreement with the County of Passaic to enter into the Cooperative Pricing System on or about March 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services by a local contracting unit through a joint agreement and/or cooperative marketing is authorized by the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-10, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Coronis Health RMC, LLC has been awarded the Passaic County Cooperative Contract for emergency medical billing services by the County of Passaic, as the Lead Agency, in accordance with contract award rendered pursuant to County of Passaic Resolution No. 23-0377; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Diver Fire Chief has recommended that the Town utilize this contract for emergency medical services billing as a means of achieving cost reductions and other efficiencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Dover, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Town Council hereby concur with the recommendation of the Fire Chief and authorizes the award of a contract with Coronis Health RMC, LLC through the Passaic County Cooperative Pricing System #38PCCP for emergency medical services billing; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Town Clerk, along with any other individuals designated by the Mayor, are hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as are necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
